ENTRY IS FREE and open to all COFA students who are Arc members.

GOLDEN TICKET is the 2007 Emerging Artists and Designer Awards. The non-acquisitive award is open to current students working in all disciplines at COFA and will result in an exhibition of selected works at Kudos Gallery 10 – 20 October, 2007.

Artists and designers enrolled at COFA in 2007 are invited to submit up to three works for pre-selection by the Kudos Gallery Management Committee. Those selected finalists will be presented at Kudos Gallery for judging and

exhibition. The judges for GOLDEN TICKET are external professionals in the arts and design industries.

In addition to the major award, there are a number of amazing prizes donated from local businesses to be won (see back of entry form for details). The GOLDEN TICKET Award winners will be announced on Tuesday 9 October at the opening of the exhibition 6 - 8pm, Kudos Gallery, 6 Napier St. Paddington.

The Emerging Artist and Designer Awards are presented by the Arc.

Now in its sixth year, the Award aims to promote excellence in visual art and design at COFA, to encourage experimentation and development of process, material and concept, to display COFA art and design to the broader community and to nurture creative activity and community within the Paddington campus of UNSW.

Finalists will be announced. For the full list of finalists visit the Arc website www.arc.unsw.edu.au on this day. Entrants not selected for final judging and exhibition will be required to collect their work from the Arc office by 5pm Monday 8 October.

9 OCTOBER

Judging of finalists at Kudos Gallery.

Opening Night of the GOLDEN TICKET Exhibition at Kudos Gallery from 6-8pm. Opening address and presentation of awards at 6.45pm.

20 OCTOBER

The GOLDEN TICKET exhibition closes at 4pm.

22 OCTOBER

Exhibiting finalists are required to collect their work from Kudos Gallery between 9am and 11am.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Entrants must be enrolled students at UNSW College of Fine Arts in 2007, and members of the Arc. All areas of study are invited to enter.
2. Entries must have been completed within the 12 months prior to 8 October 2007.
3. Entries can be in any medium.
4. The 2007 Emerging Artist and Designer Award is non-acquisitive.
5. All work must be the original work and concept of the artist/s; group work will also be accepted.
6. Up to three works may be entered by each entrant.
7. Submitted work must not exceed 1.5 meters square, inclusive of framing if the work is framed.
8. Performance-based work must be submitted as documentation. eg. film, photograph.
9. All work must be ready for hanging/installation and clearly labelled with the entrant's name and the title of the work. Any special installation specifications must be clearly presented with the entry.
10. Entrants must complete the entry form provided in this document and submit this with the entry. The Artist/Designer statement must not exceed the space provided.
11. No responsibility will be taken for loss or damage of artwork. Entrants must provide their own insurance if required. Special care will be taken when handling entries.
12. Entrants must observe the delivery and collection dates outlined in this document. The Arc has limited storage and can not guarantee safe storage before or after the Award exhibition.
13. Work selected for exhibition may be for sale with 25% of the sale amount retained by the Arc. If registered with an ABN, sale price must include GST.
14. Installation of work for the exhibition will be done in consultation with Kudos Gallery staff. Special requirements will be considered but final decision will be with the Arc.
15. Submission of entry form automatically constitutes entrant's acceptance of all Terms and Conditions.
16. All finalists whose work is exhibited will be expected to fulfil a shift in the gallery-minding roster. The exhibition is open for two weeks, 11am - 6pm Wednesday to Friday and 11am - 4pm Saturday.
